

A GUIDE TO REGISTERING YOUR VEHICLE & LICENCING YOUR VEHICLE

There are two main parts to vehicle ownership

- · Registering your vehicle
- Licensing your vehicle

Registering your vehicle

If you have imported a vehicle it must be registered with Inland Revenue before you can get a vehicle licence. To do this, you will need to provide IRD with the importation documentation and a completed application form for registration of a motor vehicle (TR01).

If you have purchased a vehicle from another owner both of you will be required to complete the bottom section of the Vehicle Registration Certificate. This is the proof and confirmation of the ownership transfer.

Upon receiving either of these forms Inland Revenue will issue a Vehicle Registration Certificate for the owner. This must be kept in the vehicle at all times. This certificate will also be used when ownership is transferred in the future.

Licensing your Vehicle

There are a number of steps in the licensing process.

Step 1. Vehicle Inspection

Go to the Ministry of Infrastructure and Development (MID) and pay for your inspection fee.

Take the receipt to the Public Works Department to arrange a time for them to inspect your vehicle. If you are prepared to wait they can often do it then.

Step 2. Insurance

Third party insurance is compulsory. It can be purchased from one of 2 insurance companies (QBE and Tower) or through a broker.

Step 3. Issue of Licence

Bring your certificate of inspection and third party insurance policy to IRD, along with a completed 'Application for Licensing a Motor Vehicle' form (TRO3).

IRD will process the application and provide you with a vehicle licence for you to display on the left hand side of your windscreen.
